Selected entries from published station references; transcription, not an original roster for Charles.

AAF station list, May 1, 1944

India-China Wing, Air Transport Command

Station #1 — Calcutta, India; APO192

Station #6 — Chabua, India; APO629

Station #13 — Kunming, China; APO627

Later designations in the published unit compilation

Station #1: replaced by 1300 AAFBU.

Station #13: replaced by 1340 AAFBU.

AAFBU means Army Air Forces Base Unit.

Reading this reference

The station list identifies unit locations in May 1944. It does not prove the date an individual soldier arrived, departed or traveled. An APO is an Army Post Office address; the postal address alone is not proof of physical location.
